

# Mountain Folk Festival

Friday March 20 and Saturday March 21

**Who?** Young Dancers from 4th grade through high school who come in dance groups from their school or other group, having learned the required dances, accompanied by their dance leader/teacher and chaperones.

**What?** The Festival starts on Friday morning and goes through Saturday night at 9:30, with an informal afterparty. Dance classes and practices last all day, with breaks for meals. The whole festival registration costs \$25 per dancer. T-shirts are available by pre-order for \$6. There is an optional \$5 spaghetti supper to raise funds for the local school-age dance group which tours internationally. Groups stay in local motels which they arrange themselves with our assistance.

**Where?** Most activities are held in Seabury Center or close by, on Berea College campus.

**When?** Friday and Saturday, March 20-21, 2009.

**Why?** To educate the next generation of dancers to the joy of dance and carrying on a 73-year tradition of folk dance for young people at Berea College.
