*In March of 2009, President Larry Shinn announced the creation of a Scenario Planning Taskforce to develop three possible scenarios for a future Berea that honor Berea's core mission but that also operate with an institutional budget that is 25 percent smaller. This initiative came, in part, because of the stock market's decline and the impact on Berea's budget, but also in response to his awareness of a changing landscape in terms of expectations and support for higher education. President Shinn will offer a brief summary of the scenario planning process and then open the floor for questions from alumni and friends who share an interest in positively shaping Berea's future.*
