2009 Brushy Fork Annual Institute West Virginia Community Team Scholarship Application

Brushy Fork Institute is collaborating with the West Virginia Community Development Hub to make scholarships for the 2009 Annual Institute available for teams in the communities the Hub has identified. These scholarships are made possible through a grant from the Claude Worthington Benedum Foundation.



Scholarship Criteria

1. To qualify for a community team scholarship, a community team must be from one of the following Hub communities or counties:

Hub Communities: Ansted, Fairmont Southside, Huntington, Mullens, Salem, Shinnston, St. Albans, Williamson, Winding Gulf

Hub Counties: Clay County, Doddridge County, Fayette County, Gilmer County, Harrison County, Lincoln County, Marshall County, McDowell County, Monroe County, Pleasants County, Ritchie County

2. A community team is made up of at least 3 people from the same Hub community or Hub county (from list above) who are working toward community change.

3. If a member of the community team has attended the Annual Institute in the past using a Benedum-funded scholarship, they must be one of the team members who pays the full registration fee.

Potential Team Structure for Scholarships

The first two team members pay the full registration fee of \$450, the third member is free, the fourth member pays half price (\$225), and the fifth member is free. See examples below.
