Appalachian Rural Development Philanthropy Initiative Kentucky Distressed Community Team Scholarship Application

2011 Brushy Fork Annual Institute

The Brushy Fork Annual Institute provides training for community leaders and organizations throughout central Appalachia. Through the Appalachian Rural Development Philanthropy Initiative, community teams from economically distressed counties interested in pursuing planning around local philanthropy are eligible for scholarships made possible through funding from the Appalachian Regional Commission. Registration for the 2011 Annual Institute is \$500. Under this scholarship program, the first three team members pay only \$250 each. Any additional team members pay \$100 each. Lodging will be reimbursed at 50 percent of actual upon submission of receipts, up to a maximum of \$500 per team.

Scholarship Criteria

- The community must be classified as an economically distressed Kentucky county. These counties are: **Adair, Bath, Bell, Breathitt, Carter, Casey, Clay, Clinton, Cumberland, Elliott, Estill, Floyd, Harlan, Hart, Jackson, Johnson, Knott, Knox, Lawrence, Lee, Leslie, Letcher, Lewis, Lincoln, McCreary, Magoffin, Martin, Menifee, Metcalfe, Monroe, Morgan, Owsley, Perry, Powell, Robertson, Rockcastle, Russell, Wayne, Whitley and Wolfe.**
- A community team must have at least 3 members.
- Team members must be residents of the distressed county.
- Teams must be committed to working on a local philanthropy effort.
- No more than 50 percent of the team members can be part of the same organization.

Registration Scholarships

1st person pays \$250.00 and receives a \$250.00 scholarship
2nd person pays \$250.00 and receives a \$250.00 scholarship
3rd person pays \$250.00 and receives a \$250.00 scholarship
4th person pays \$100 and receives a \$400.00 scholarship
Each additional person pays \$100 and receives a \$400 scholarship

Examples

- A team of 3 people would pay a total of \$750 and receive a scholarship of \$750.
- A team of 5 would pay a total of \$950 and receive a scholarship of \$1,550.

Each team will also receive a 50 percent reimbursement of lodging costs upon submission of receipts, up to a maximum of \$500 per team for lodging.
