2011 Brushy Fork Annual Institute West Virginia Scholarship Application

Brushy Fork Institute is collaborating with the West Virginia Community Development Hub to make scholarships for the 2011 Annual Institute available for organizations or community teams in a Hub Focus community. These scholarships are made possible through a grant from the Claude Worthington Benedum Foundation.

Criteria to Qualify for a Scholarship

1. To qualify, an organization or community team must be from one of the following Hub 2011 Focus Communities:

Hub Communities: Ansted, Buckhannon, Fairmont Southside, Huntington, Mullens, Salem, Shinnston, St. Albans, Williamson,

Hub Counties: Clay County, Doddridge County, Fayette County, Gilmer County, Harrison County, Lincoln County, Marshall County, McDowell County, Monroe County, Pleasants County, Ritchie County, Roane County, Wayne County, Wetzel County and Wyoming County

Scholarship Amount Information

The first and second representative from an organization or community receives a scholarship worth \$300 and pays a registration fee of \$200. If an organization or community sends three representatives (from the same organization or community), the third participant receives a full scholarship worth \$500.

*For teams of more than 3 additional scholarship monies may be available on a case-by-case basis.
