This is in accordance with the health policy stated in the CDL Parent Handbook:  
“Children are not permitted to attend with any of the following symptoms: contagious rash, fever greater than 101 degrees, untreated earache, sore throat, diarrhea occurring more than three times in 24 hours, chronic cough (defined as turning the face red or blue or involving a high pitched croup-like whooping sound, vomiting, ringworm, or discharge from the eyes.” Children developing any of the above symptoms (or a significant injury-requiring professional medical treatment/attention) during the day must be picked up by a parent or caregiver because the CDL does not have adequate isolation facilities for children with such symptoms. In order to return to the CDL, a child must be free of illness for 24 hours, have received a full 24-hour course of medical treatment, or a doctors statement stating their return is safe for others in the center.
