ABOUT TRIO:

Upward Bound and UB Math & Science (WI) are Berea College programs that serve high school students from south central Kentucky. Through the TRIO Programs, students get the opportunity to prepare for college while still in high school.

At no cost to their families, TRIO students can participate in activities such as:

- **Cultural Field Trips** – Travel to places like Nashville & Cincinnati for Broadway shows & museum visits
- **Career Exploration** – Discover a college major that interests YOU
- **Campus Visits** – Explore colleges and universities “live & in person”
- **Campus living experience** – Spend six weeks living at Berea College & find out what college life is like
- **Unique, Interactive Classes** – Enjoy new educational experiences unavailable to you in high school
- **Study skills** – Learn habits that can improve your grades
- **ACT preparation** – Take the test for free & gain skills to improve your score
- **Financial aid form assistance** – Find out how to pay for college & apply for grants, scholarships, & loans
- **Help with college applications & essays**

HOW TO APPLY:

Complete the entire application form. **Please do not write in cursive; print all information.** Return your application with a transcript and test scores. Applications for the program are accepted on a rolling basis and will be periodically reviewed for admission. The final application deadline is May 31st. We encourage you to return your application as soon as possible, because spaces will be filled as applications from qualified students become complete. A complete application will include the following:

- _____ Completed application form
- _____ Copy of your most recent transcript
- _____ Copy of your KCCT scores (or other state administered standardized test scores)
- _____ One reference form completed by a teacher, guidance counselor, or another person able to attest to your character and potential for success; Math/Science applicants should make sure their form is from a math or science teacher.

NOTE: All of these items are NEEDED for your application to be considered and, when they are received with the application, it will speed the application process.

QUALIFICATIONS:

In order to be eligible for consideration, applicants MUST meet the following criteria:

- _____ Must be currently enrolled in the 9th, 10th or 11th grade in high school
- _____ Must meet income and/or first generation criteria (the TRIO staff will determine eligibility from your application and supporting documents)
- _____ Must have an interest in going to college; Math/Science applicants should have an interest in pursuing a career in a math or science-related field
