Both Berea College and the University of the Cumberlands Forensics Alumni Association proudly invite you to attend the John G. Fee Memorial and Curtis Brown Memorial I.E. Swing on October 23-24, 2009. We are excited to offer two I.E. tourneys **and** parli debate in only a two day format and hope you will join us.

Curtis Brown Invitational (Friday I.E. Swing) – Cumberland will host an IE swing on Friday **WITH FINALS** for the usual AFA events. BECAUSE OF TIME LIMITATIONS, DEBATERS MAY NOT PARTICIPATE IN FRIDAY’S I.E. EVENTS





John G. Fee Invitational (Debate and Saturday I.E.s) - NPDA parliamentary debate will be offered Friday and Saturday as well as the usual AFA individual events, with a 2/1 format, on Saturday. DEBATERS MAY ENTER BOTH DEBATE AND THE BERA I.E. TOURNEY.

JUDGES: As last year, we anticipate that hired judges will be few in number, so please plan to provide enough judges to cover your entries; avoid the extra fees for uncovered judges.

The entry deadline for these events is Friday, October 16, 2008 by 5:00 p.m. Entries for both tournaments may be faxed to Billy Wooten at (859) 985-3906 by 5 p.m. with a cover page with “Berea Debate” as the subject. **However, email entries are preferred at wootenb@berea.edu** Any questions, call Billy Wooten at (859) 985-3762

Directions to Berea College

From 75 South:

Friday: Take Berea Exit 76, take a right at the end of the exit onto US 25 and continue through six red lights. At the sixth red light, continue left at the split and turn left into Seabury Center parking lot. Follow the signs to the Phelps Stokes registration building. *As classes are in session Friday, parking is limited to the lot below campus, so for those who want to drop people off nearer the registration building, follow the Saturday directions to the drop off point and then go park in the lower Seabury lot.*

Saturday: Take Berea Exit 76, take a right at the end of the exit onto US 25 and continue through four red lights. At the fourth red light, turn left, and then take the first road on the right (Campus Drive). Park in spaces on campus drive and follow signs to Draper Building.

From 75 North:

Friday: Take Berea Exit 77, turn left at stop light. At the second stop light, turn right. Go about two miles and go through the next stop light. Take a right into Seabury Center parking lot. Walk up the hill to get to the main campus. *As classes are in session Friday, parking is limited to the lot below campus, so for those who want to drop people off nearer the registration building, follow the Saturday directions to the drop off point and then go park in the lower Seabury lot.*

Saturday: Take Berea Exit 77, turn left at stop light. At the second stop light, turn right. Go about two miles and turn right at the next stop light. Continue on this road, proceed straight through the next stop light and take the first road on your left (Campus Drive). Park in spaces on campus drive and follow signs to Draper Building.



Parking

Just to make this point again, on Friday, the most convenient parking lot that would allow easy access to all of the buildings being used in the tournament is the Seabury Gym Lot. There will be signs to guide you to this area. Saturday parking should not be a problem anywhere on campus (I recommend Campus Drive behind Draper Building).



Lodging

There are several hotels in the area. However, for your convenience, we have chosen the **Fairfield Inn (1007 Paint Lick Road)** as the tournament hotel and reserved a block of 20 rooms for Friday night. The rate for this hotel is \$65 per night, but you must **call by September 23rd** and request the Berea College Debate Block in order to reserve a room for this price.
