Virtual Learning Community**

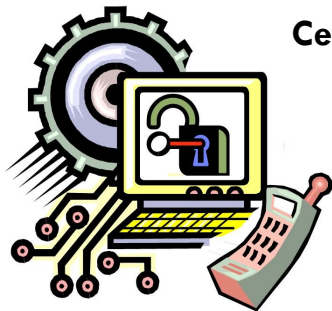
This award is given to the school who has implemented a major new application or has significantly enhanced an existing system that improves operational performance and/or service for all or part of its students, faculty, and staff.
