Position Title: Corner Pocket Attendant

Must Work 10 hrs/wk.

1 Grade Level: 2-3

2a Description: The following are the essential duties for a Corner Pocket Attendant in the Campus Life Department:

- a. Directs check out of all equipment for the game areas and enforces building and College policies and regulations
- b. Assists in the operation of competitions or other programs in the game area
- c. Performs custodial duties of the Corner Pocket area and maintains game room equipment
- d. Participates with Friday night rotations (7-11 PM)
- e. Performs other job-related duties as assigned

2b Description: the following are *possible additional* duties for this position:

- a. Helps to monitor and inventory the Corner Pocket equipment/supplies
- b. Works occasionally during Corner Pocket reservations (i.e. birthday parties, reunions)
- c. See that the workplace and environs are clean

- d. Voluntarily participating in activities sponsored by this department
