Position Title: Student Concessions Worker

Must work 0-5 hrs/wk.

**I. Grade Level: 0-5**

**II. Description:**

A. The following are the essential duties for a Concessions Worker in Seabury Concessions: Working during the season (second week of October to the last week in March, possibly first week in April):

1. Serve customers food and drinks during games.
2. Arrive one-half hour before games to help set up concessions.
3. Clean up stand after games.
4. Follow health laws relevant to food handling.
5. Attend and pass 1-session food service handlers class.
6. Performs other job-related duties as assigned.

A. The following are *possible additional* duties for this position:  
None except those identified as essential above.

**III. Learning Opportunities:**

- A. Food handling skills: diseases, temperature required for food served, food storage.
- B. People skills.
- C. Customer service skills.
- D. How to handle self and others in an intense, stressful work environment demanding immediate decision making on occasion: only have 20-30 minutes in which to serve food at each game.
- E. Time management skills.

**IV. Basic Qualifications:**

- A. General: dependability, aggressive selling ability, flexibility in work demands, farsightedness, initiative-taking (kind of person who is always looking for work to be done), not easily flustered in a complex, demanding fast-paced situation, even temperament.
- B. Skill: Good planning skills, math aptitude/ability to count.
- C. Physical: Mobility, ability to lift 50 pounds.
- D. Academic: None.

**V. Desirable Qualifications:**

- A. Friendliness.

**VI. Narrative Summary:**

Student sold food and drink at athletic games in concessions stand; helped to clean stand after games; and passed class on health laws related to food handling.
