RECYCLABLE ITEMS	INSTRUCTIONS
<b>WHITE &amp; COLOR PAPER</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>⇒ Notebook paper</li><li>⇒ Office paper</li><li>⇒ Envelopes</li><li>⇒ Shredded paper</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>⇒ Staples OK</li><li>⇒ No paper plates, cups</li><li>⇒ No paper towels, tissues</li><li>⇒ No candy wrappers or contaminants</li></ul>
<b>NEWSPAPERS/MAGAZINES</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>⇒ Newspapers</li><li>⇒ Phone books</li><li>⇒ Glossy paper</li><li>⇒ Sales papers</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>⇒ Remove plastic wrappers</li><li>⇒ No laminated paper</li></ul>
<b>CARDBOARD/BOOKS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>⇒ Corrugated cardboard</li><li>⇒ Paperboard (thin cardboard)</li><li>⇒ Hardback and paperback books</li><li>⇒ Notebooks</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>⇒ Breakdown all cardboard boxes</li><li>⇒ Soda/cereal boxes OK</li><li>⇒ No food contamination (<i>NO pizza boxes!</i>)</li><li>⇒ Wire and plastic spiral binding should be removed from books</li></ul>
<b>ALUMINUM/STEEL CANS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>⇒ Soda cans</li><li>⇒ Steel/tin food cans</li><li>⇒ Empty aerosol cans</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>⇒ Crush soda cans if possible</li></ul>
<b>GLASS/PLASTICS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>⇒ Beverage containers</li><li>⇒ All plastics with  symbol</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>⇒ No broken glass</li><li>⇒ Look for recycling symbol  on bottom (#1 &amp; #2 are most common, but all are OK!)</li></ul>
