Summer Requirements!!!!

Spring is such a busy time in the Upward Bound office! So much to do before the summer. I hope you are all as excited as we are!

In addition to all the paperwork for the upcoming trips (April 24-26 for everyone) and (May 2-3 for new members), and trying to get the summer paperwork ready to go out, and hire a fantastic summer staff, we need to make sure you have everything ready for the summer.

If you are a current **JUNIOR**—**we need to have a copy of your ACT test score** in our office before or by the time you arrive for the sum-

mer. It does not have to be an official copy.

Current **SENIORS**—first of all—Congratulations! After that, as you must know by now, **we must have a copy of your FAFSA by May 10th and an acceptance letter from the college you plan to attend this fall.**

In order to be here for your Bridge summer—we must have both of those things in the office by May 10th. I am sure most all of you have already taken care of these things but we may not have copies. You can print off a copy of your FAFSA report by logging on the FAFSA
