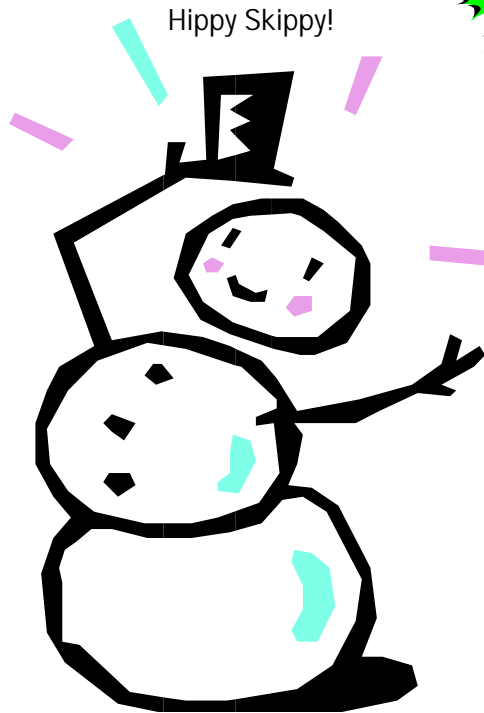

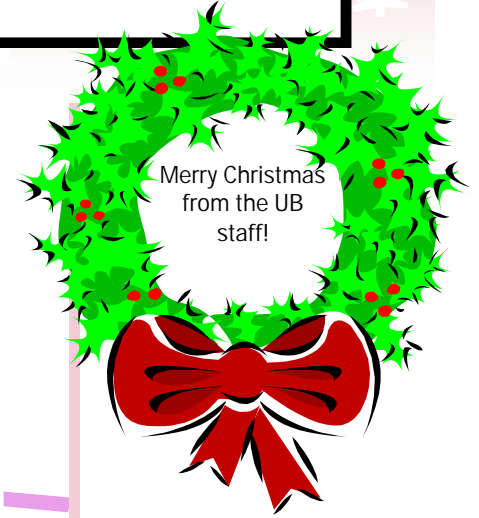
## December Already?

This event will be held January 28. Financial aid professionals will be available at 20 sites in 19 Kentucky communities to walk students and their parents through the 2007-2008 FAFSA. them use that information to complete the FAFSA.
